



# 20 Best Weekend Getaways from Seattle

Get away for a weekend of clear country air, water views, whale watching and green spaces. Properties that made our list include scenic island hideaways, cozy lodges, treehouses and hotels with spas where you can get pampered surrounded by nature.

There are ideas for couples, families with kids and single travelers. Remember to book your room, activities and transportation early during the holiday weekends and look for specials during the low season. Approximate driving times from Seattle are included to help you plan your trip.

## » Willows Lodge - 30 minutes

---

A 30-minute drive from the city, Willows Lodge is located in Woodinville wine country on 5 quiet acres. The lodge serves excellent food coupled with delicious wines. Reserve a table at the award-winning Herbfarm Restaurant and have a nine-course dinner to celebrate a special occasion or make a romantic wedding proposal. Guest rooms have fireplaces which invite you to relax with a book, followed by a bath in the soaking tub for two.



The Spa offers a varied menu of treatments, from Lomi Lomi massages, body wraps and exclusive Carita Facials. Once you are done with your massages, explore the surrounding area by bike, take a wine tasting tour and take a stroll through the hotel gardens. Northwest Coast Native American art is exhibited throughout the property, in the gardens and in public spaces. The Barking Frog restaurant serves delicious dishes with Pacific Northwest influences.

The restaurant has received Wine Spectator's Award of Excellence five years in a row. The property is a 25-minute drive from Seattle which makes it a quick getaway from the city. Western Washington's wine country offers many scenic spots, great restaurants and wine tours. Nightly room rates at the Willows Lodge start at \$199 per night ([website](#)).

## » Salish Lodge and Spa - 35 minutes

Popular with couples and honeymooners, Salish Lodge and Spa overlooks the dramatic Snoqualmie Falls, 30 minutes from the city.

Originally built in 1916, the hotel has

been completely renovated and offers all of the modern amenities. One of the top weekend getaways in the Pacific Northwest, [Salish Lodge](#) has romantic rooms and a relaxing spa.



Guest rooms have whirlpool tubs and wood-burning fireplaces. Check into one of the top floor suites for the best views of the falls. Rates start at \$199 per night.

## » Suncadia Resort - 1 hour 25 minutes

A year-round getaway with a golf course, spa, ice skating rink, a winery and several dining options, Suncadia Resort offers [skiing](#) in the winter and hiking in the summer. The resort is located on 6,400 acres, 80 miles east of Seattle, Washington. Guests can dine at two restaurants and two bars, swim in the pool and work out in the fitness center.

## » Free Spirit Spheres - 5 hours 35 minutes

Although this getaway is a longer drive than others included in our collection, if you are looking for a bit of inspiration out in nature, rent one of the Free Spirit Spheres in the rain forest of Vancouver Island, [Canada](#). Measuring from 9 to 10.5 feet in diameter, the spheres create cozy rooms in the trees.

Choose from three spheres: Eve is the smallest, Eryn is handcrafted from wood, and Melody is the newest sphere, made from fiberglass. Shared composting toilets are located at the base of the spheres. The property also offers 2 washrooms, 2 showers, a sauna and a covered deck with barbeque and picnicking resources. Nightly rates at Free Spirit Spheres start at \$145. The property does not accommodate children under 16. ([website](#))

## » Five Pine Lodge - 5 hours 30 minutes

A weekend hideaway in Sisters, Oregon, the Romance Cabin at the Five Pine Lodge was built especially for couples. The private cabin has a sunken bath tub next to a stone fireplace, perfect for a [romantic getaway](#). You can unplug from the world and take long soothing baths while the room is warmed by the fireplace, or watch your favorite movie on the 42-inch plasma flat screen television right from the bath tub. ## » The Inn at Langley

The Inn at Langley is about one hour from the city and has rooms with 180-degree water views and cozy fireplaces. In the morning, wake up to the smell of homemade muffins, muesli and fresh fruit. There are 26 guest rooms with floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking Saratoga Passage and Cascade Mountains. The property is located in the heart of the village of Langley, near antique stores, art galleries and boutiques. The island offers a number of exciting things to do, including whale watching, sea kayaking, scuba diving, biking, golf and fishing. Enjoy a relaxing massage at the Essencia Spa.

The Chef's Kitchen Restaurant serves delicious meals that incorporate fresh seasonal ingredients. The restaurant features an open display kitchen, and overlooks a formal herb garden.
